

How to Block Spam Calls

Stop telemarketers and robocalls automatically on your iPhone or Android.

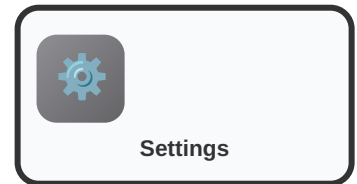
Important Rule: Before you turn this on, make sure your doctors, family members, and friends are saved in your **Contacts list**. If they aren't saved, their calls will go straight to voicemail!

FOR APPLE IPHONE USERS

STEP 1 Open the Settings App

Look for the **Settings** icon on your home screen.

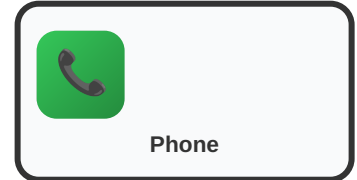
- It looks like a set of **gray gears**.



STEP 2 Tap on "Phone"

Scroll down quite a bit until you find the **Phone** option.

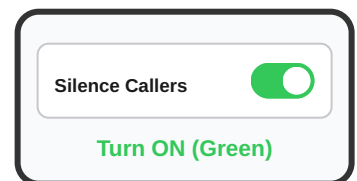
- It has a green square icon with a white telephone.
- Tap anywhere on that line.



STEP 3 Turn on "Silence Unknown Callers"

Scroll down and tap **Silence Unknown Callers**.

- Tap the switch so it turns **Green (ON)**.
- *Result:* Numbers not in your contacts will no longer ring out loud; they will go silently to voicemail.

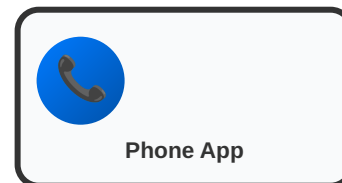


FOR ANDROID USERS (SAMSUNG, GOOGLE, ETC.)

STEP 1 Open the Phone App

Go to your home screen and tap your **Phone app** (the app you use to make calls).

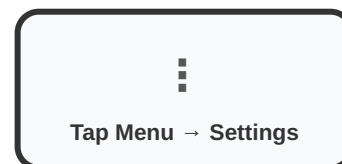
- It is usually a blue or green circle with a phone receiver.



STEP 2 Open Settings (Three Dots)

Look in the **top right corner** of the screen for three little dots.

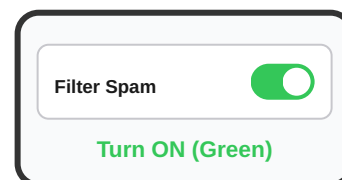
- Tap the three dots to open a menu.
- Tap **Settings** from the drop-down list.



STEP 3 Turn on Spam Filtering

Look for an option named **Caller ID & Spam** (or just "Spam").

- Turn ON **Filter spam calls**.
- *Result:* Your phone will automatically block suspected scam numbers from ever ringing.



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
