

How to Make Text Bigger on Your iPhone

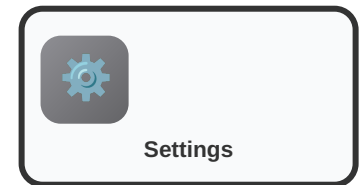
Follow these 4 easy steps to adjust your screen so text is comfortable to read.

Tip: Changing this setting makes the text larger across your entire phone—including your **Messages, Mail, Contacts, and Notes!**

STEP 1 Open the Settings App

Look for the **Settings** icon on your iPhone home screen.

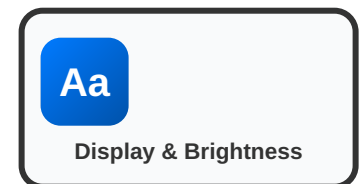
- It looks like a set of **gray gears**.
- Tap the icon once to open your phone settings.



STEP 2 Tap "Display & Brightness"

Scroll down through the menu until you see **Display & Brightness**.

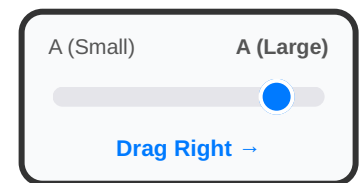
- It has a blue icon with two letter "A"s.
- Tap anywhere on that line to open display options.



STEP 3 Adjust the Text Size Slider

Tap **Text Size** near the middle of the screen.

- Drag the white circle at the bottom to the **RIGHT** to make words bigger.
- The sample text above the slider will grow instantly so you can pick your preferred size.



STEP 4 Need Extra-Large Text? (Optional)

If you need even larger text, go to **Settings → Accessibility → Display & Text Size → Larger Text**.

- Turn ON **Larger Accessibility Sizes** to unlock extra-large text options.
